"Supporting the families of ill and injured Canadian Forces personnel and the families of the fallen."

The Family Liaison Officer is a MFRC Social Worker who is located in the IPSC (Integrated Personnel Support Centre). Your IPSC team provides support during all phases of recovery, and rehabilitation as well as reintegration support for those returning to CF service. These services are free of charge, and are delivered by experienced professionals. The services offered are: confidential individual, family or group counseling, referrals to mental health services for adults and children, access to education and prevention-based programs in the community, short-term individual or group support for families of ill, injured and deceased CF personnel; and outreach support to families in the surrounding area.

Veteran Family Coordinator

The Veteran Family Program is a four-year pilot extending the Military Family Services Program (MFSP) to medically-released Veterans and their families for a period of two years from the date of release.

When a Canadian Armed Forces (CAF) member makes the transition from active service to veteran status, their family does too. Releasing from the CAF can be challenging for members and families, but even more so when the release is the result of a medical condition.

Support is available to your family as you journey through this transition.

Moving to a new location can be challenging. Included is information, which we hope will relieve some of the stress you may be experiencing. If you feel that we may enhance this package by adding extra information, we encourage you to contact our Community Integration Coordinator. If the appliance is still in good working order, it can be sold or sent to a second hand store. If the appliance is no longer working, there are a number of alternatives. The City of North Bay, Merrick Landfill Site will accept appliances based on the tipping fee schedule see website address below.

Local scrap dealers may accept white goods – please call them for details.

Household hazardous waste is found in every home, and usually consists of common household chemical products that are hazardous if disposed of improperly. If you have items or are unsure of how to dispose of these products, the Hazardous Waste Depot is in operation from April to October, Wednesdays through Saturdays from 8 am to 6 pm at 112 Patton Rd.
